### Job Purpose and Reporting Structure:

Under the supervision of the Program Manager, provide individual, group, and family counseling to child and adolescent sexual abuse survivors.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

1. Interview and assess clients between the ages of 6 – 18 years of age who have experienced sexual abuse victimization. Also address related problems such as personal and family adjustments, housing, school, and physical and mental impairments, using assessment tools to determine nature and degree of problem. Secure information, such as medical, psychological, and social factors contributing to client's situation and evaluate these and the client's capacities.
2. Counsel clients individually in office, in family, possible at home site, and in therapeutic groups regarding sexual abuse and surrounding issues. Develop treatment plans for meeting client's needs and help client to modify attitudes and patterns of behavior. Review treatment plan and revise as needed to determine quantity and quality of service provided to client.
3. Provide case management, crisis intervention, and advocacy services, including service coordination as necessary. Refer clients to community resources and other organizations, as appropriate.
4. Participate in weekly supervision and regular group clinical consultation.
5. Compile records and prepare reports, including case files and correspondence with client and other mental health and social service providers involved. Develop, maintain, and submit necessary reports for program evaluation and statistical compilation. Records must be compliant with program policies and HIPAA regulations.
6. Participate in resource fairs, outreach speaking engagements, and development opportunities. Attend program and agency staff meetings as required.
7. Other duties may be assigned.

### Supervisory Responsibilities:

None required.

### Requirements:

- Requires a Master's degree in social work, educational psychology, or psychology.
- Prefer State of Wisconsin licensure as a clinical social worker, professional counselor, or marriage and family therapist.
- Requires two years' experience working with families or youth.
- Must possess working knowledge of the issues of sexual assault and the impact of trauma on victims and their families.
- Must possess working knowledge of family dynamics and have the ability to conduct family counseling sessions.
- Must be available for after school and evening appointments.
- Must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, and be able to maintain privileged client information.
- Must have valid driver's license, reliable vehicle, and proof of auto insurance.
